## Advance Works Notice Port River Rail Bridge (Outer Harbor Line)

Dear Business Owner/Property Owner/Resident,

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) will be upgrading the Port River Rail Bridge during January 2017 to ensure reliable and efficient rail services along the Outer Harbor line.

To facilitate these works, the Outer Harbor and Grange rail lines will be closed from the last train service on Sunday, 1 January 2017 and will re-open for the first train service on Tuesday, 24 January 2017.

The \$4 million upgrade includes replacing the existing dilapidated steel bridge spans and is expected to extend the life of the 105 metre long Port River Bridge, built in 1910, by approximately 75 years.

The works will include removal and replacement of the existing steel bridge spans. The new bridge spans are 10.5 metres long and 2.8 metres wide, with separate spans for the up and down rail tracks. The bridge consists of a total of 20 spans made from Australian steel and each span weighs 10 tonnes.

### How will these works affect me?

All works will take place between 6am and midnight each day, weather permitting, with works possibly extended to 24 hours a day, if required. Advance notice will be provided to local residents if this is to occur.

The shared use path on the western side of the Port River between Bower Road and the bridge may be closed intermittently. In these instances, detailed signage will be in place directing path users to an alternate route via the footpath along Causeway and Bower Roads.

### Noise

Every effort will be made to minimise noise impacts to nearby businesses and residents. However, some noise will be unavoidable during this period.


### Public Transport Services
